

Post Exposure (needle-stick) Prophylaxis Kit (PEP Kit)

The PEP kit (Post Exposure Prophylaxis Kit) will be located in the EMER Pyxis machine located in immediate care in the emergency department. The PEP kit will be utilized to dispense a one day supply of medication for staff who have experienced a needle stick or other exposure requiring prophylaxis for HIV who are unable to fill the outpatient prescription in a timely manner.

Important Note: for Stony Brook employees, please send PEP Rx to Fairview Pharmacy ONLY - Phone 631-474-7828 Fax: 631-474-7871 Make a notation that this is a work related exposure. Do not use "preferred pharmacy".

The patient/employee will be encountered in the hospital system and the kit will be removed from Pyxis using the override function.

PEP kit contents:

Emtricitabine-Tenofovir (Truvada) 200-300mg tab quantity 1

Raltegravir 400mg tab quantity 2

Patient education leaflets for Emtricitabine-Tenofovir (Truvada) and Raltegravir (Isentress)

The physician will need to write the patients name, date, patients address, and doctor's name on each label. The physician will dispense the medication to the patient.

If more than a one day supply is needed, additional kits may be dispensed (usually no more than 2 will be needed). The number of kits removed from Pyxis MUST be indicated in Pyxis at the time of vending.
